Mr. Adrian Genre, Director of Utilities, was recognized and explained to the Council the work that has been done in the past week, where the Arena well went offline and the Westgate Well was used to compensate, which resulted in the southend of the Parish getting brown water. Mr. Genre also explained the failure of the metering station down

Riverboat Lane where a tree fell on the station, along with a leak on Lukeville which was in the process of being repaired. Mr. Genre went on to explain the reasons for the lag in garbage and recycling pickup this past week, mainly being due to storm damage around the area, fueling issues, and landfill closures. There were a few questions from the Council.

ORDINANCE 24 OF 2023

As Introduced by the West Baton Rouge Parish Council
At the Regular Meeting of June 8, 2023
And Adopted on June 22, 2023

An Ordinance Adopting An Operating Budget Of Revenues And Expenditures For The Fiscal Year Beginning July 1, 2023 And Ending June 30, 2024 As Published By The West Baton Rouge Parish Council On Aging

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Parish of West Baton Rouge, Louisiana in regular session convened that:

SECTION 1: The attached detailed estimate of revenues for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023 and ending June 30, 2024 be and is hereby adopted as an operating budget of revenues for the West Baton Rouge Parish Council on Aging during said period.

SECTION 2: The attached detailed estimate of expenditures for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023 and ending June 30, 2024 be and is hereby adopted as an operating budget of expenditures for the West Baton Rouge Parish Council on Aging during said period.

SECTION 3: The adoption of this operating budget of revenues and expenditures are hereby declared to operate as an appropriation of the amount therein set forth within the terms of the budget classification.

SECTION 4: Amounts are available for expenditures only the extent included within said budget.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Parish Council of the Parish of West Baton Rouge, Louisiana, that this ordinance shall become effective pursuant to Section 2-12 (C) of the Home Rule Charter.

NOW THEREFORE BE IF FURTHER ORDAINED by the West Baton Rouge Parish Council, that all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed in their entirety.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Parish Council of the Parish of West Baton Rouge, Louisiana, that if any provision or item of this ordinance or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions, items or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions, items, or applications of this ordinance are hereby declared severable.

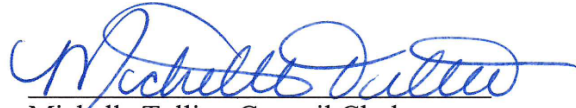

ORDINANCE 25 OF 2023

As Introduced by the West Baton Rouge Parish Council
At the Regular Meeting of June 8, 2022
And Adopted on June 22, 2023

An Ordinance Amending The West Baton Rouge Parish Code of Ordinances, Louisiana, Amending Chapter 22 (Elections), Article II (Voting Districts), Section 22-25, (Generally), 22-26 (Designated), 22-27 (Voting District Descriptions), Article III (Voting Districts and Polling Places), Section 22-58 (Precinct Descriptions), and 22-59 (Polling Places) as adopted on June 9, 2022.

WHEREAS, on June 9, 2022 West Baton Rouge Parish Council adopted **Ordinance 25 of 2022, and 26 of 2022**, a new election district plan in accordance with the 2020 Census and in compliance with the Voting Rights Act and applicable Louisiana state statutes; **AND**

WHEREAS, the West Baton Rouge Parish Council has confirmed acceptance of this plan by the State Legislative Office and the Louisianan Secretary of State Office as by law; **AND**

WHEREAS, this ordinance is to format and codify the aforementioned ordinances into the WBR Parish Code of Ordinances.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the West Baton Rouge Parish Council, in regular session assembled, does hereby amend the following election information as previously adopted for codification purposes.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the West Baton Rouge Parish Council, in legal session, Chapter 22 (Elections), Article II (Voting Districts), Section 22-25, (Generally), 22-26 (Designated), 22-27 (Voting District Descriptions), Article III (Voting Districts and Polling Places), Section 22-58 (Precinct Descriptions), and 22-59 (Polling Places) of the Compiled Ordinances of the Parish of West Baton Rouge, Louisiana, is amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

Chapter 22 – ELECTIONS

* * *

ARTICLE II. - VOTING DISTRICTS

Sec. 22-25. Generally.

Reapportioned parish council voting districts shall become effective with the opening date for qualifying as a candidate for any election held at the ~~2011~~ 2023 election, for all purposes. These voting districts shall be effective for all purposes beginning the terms of the council members on the first Monday in January following their election.

Sec. 22-26. Designated.

River Road; then northerly to the centerline of a power transmission line; then easterly to the eastern parish boundary, which is the center of the Mississippi River; then southerly, easterly and southerly to the southern parish boundary; then westerly to the centerline of Bayou Bourbeaux; then northeasterly to the centerline Coulee Canal; then northerly and easterly to the centerline of an extension of a drainage feature known as L-2 Canal; then easterly onto the centerline of an unnamed roadway north of and parallel to Quarter Horse Lane; then southeasterly to the centerline of LA Hwy. 1-South; then northerly to the centerline of Paul Lane and the point of beginning.-~~
- ~~(2) *District 2.* Beginning at the intersection of the centerlines of LA Hwy. 1-South and Ton-Ton Canal; then proceed southerly along the centerline of LA Hwy. 1-South to the centerline of W. St. Francis Street; then westerly to a drainage feature that is an extension of St. Francis Street and continue westerly to Merlin Pumping Station and the centerline of a drainage feature Ellwood Canal (known as LAT 10); then southerly to the centerline of a power transmission line; then southeasterly along the centerline of the power transmission line to the centerline of LA Hwy. 1-South; then southerly along LA Hwy. 1-South to the centerline of an unnamed roadway north of and parallel to Quarter Horse Lane; then northwesterly to the centerline of L-2 Canal, then onto to the centerline of Coulee Canal; then southwestery to the centerline of Bayou Bourbeaux; then southerly and southwestery to the intersection of the southern and western parish boundaries; then northwesterly to the centerline of Missouri-Pacific Railroad; then easterly to the centerline of the Intracoastal Canal; then northerly and northeasterly to the centerline of a power transmission line; then southeasterly to the centerline of Choctaw Basin Drainage Canal; then northeasterly to a drainage feature known as Ton-Ton Canal; then southeasterly to the centerline of LA Hwy. 1-South and the point of beginning.-~~
- ~~(3) *District 3.* Beginning at the intersection of LA Hwy. 1-South and the Intracoastal Canal, proceed easterly along the centerline of the Intracoastal Canal to the eastern parish boundary which is the center of the Mississippi River; then southerly to the centerline of a power transmission line; then easterly to the centerline of an unnamed roadway; then southerly to the centerline of an unnamed waterway (south of Paul Lane); then easterly to the centerline of S. River Road; then northerly to the centerline of Paul Lane; then easterly to the centerline of LA Hwy. 1-South; then northerly to the centerline of a power transmission line; then northwesterly to the centerline of a drainage feature known as Ellwood Canal (known as LAT 10) and the Merlin Pumping Station; then northerly to the centerline of a drainage feature that is an extension of St. Francis Street; then southeasterly continuing onto W. St. Francis Street to the centerline of LA Hwy. 1; then northeasterly to the centerline of Terrell Street; then southeasterly to the centerline of S. River Road; then northeasterly to the centerline of Fairview Avenue; then northwesterly to the centerline of the LA Hwy. 1-South Service Road; then southerly to the centerline of an access road to LA Hwy. 1-South; then westerly to the centerline of LA Hwy. 1-South; then northeasterly to the centerline of the Intracoastal Canal and the point of beginning.-~~

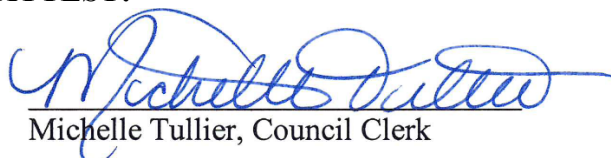

RESOLUTION 12 OF 2023

Resolution To Consider Entering Into Settlement And Release Agreement Between WBR Parish Council And Capital Area Groundwater Conservation District And Capital Area Groundwater Conservation Commission In Response To “Baton Rouge Water Works Company And West Baton Rouge Parish Council Vs. Capital Area Groundwater Conservation District And The Capital Area Groundwater Conservation Commission, 19th Judicial District Court, Parish Of East Baton Rouge, State Of Louisiana, Suit No. C-715795, Division M, Section 31.

WHEREAS, the West Baton Rouge Parish Council, a political subdivision of the State of Louisiana domiciled at 880 N. Alexander Ave., Port Allen, La 70767, and a party to the Baton Rouge Water Works Company And West Baton Rouge Parish Council Vs. Capital Area Groundwater Conservation District And The Capital Area Groundwater Conservation Commission, 19th Judicial District Court, Parish Of East Baton Rouge, State Of Louisiana, Suit No. C-715795, Division M, Section 31; and

WHEREAS, the West Baton Rouge Parish Council, seeks to enter into a settlement and release agreement with Capital Area Groundwater Conservation District and The Capital Area Groundwater Conservation Commission; and

WHEREAS, said draft of settlement and release agreement is attached hereto and identified as “Exhibit A”; and

WHEREAS, upon execution and enforcement of this agreement, within seven business days West Baton Rouge Parish Council will sign and file a Joint Dismissal With Prejudice of its claims asserted against the District and the District’s claims asserted in reconvention against West Baton Rouge Parish Council in Case No. C-715795; styled Baton Rouge Water Works Company v. Capital Area Groundwater Conservation District and the Capital Area Groundwater Conservation Commission in the 19th Judicial District Court for the Parish of East Baton Rouge with the appropriate Court; and

WHEREAS, upon receipt of a courtesy copy of the signed and filed Dismissal with Prejudice referenced above, within twenty-one business days the West Baton Rouge Parish Council, the Capital Area Groundwater Conservation District and the Capital Area Groundwater Conservation Commission will sign an Administrative Consent Agreement releasing their respective agents, assigns, or successors from any claims that have been or could have been asserted in the lawsuit under the principal of res judicata under Louisiana law and dismissing with prejudice any alleged past violations related to records of water usage or access to wells or any other statute or regulation administered by the District; and

WHEREAS, upon completion of the execution of this Agreement, the filing of the Joint Dismissal With Prejudice of the Lawsuit, and the execution of the Administrative Consent Agreement between the Parties, the District or its licensed contractor will install within 120 days a metering system on each of WBRP’s wells in accordance with AWWA specifications, the manufacturer’s recommendations, and the Capital Area Groundwater Conservation Commission’s approved metering program and contracts; and

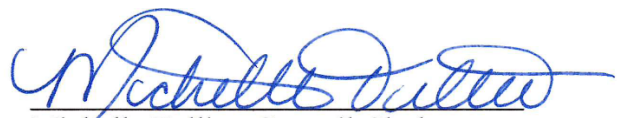

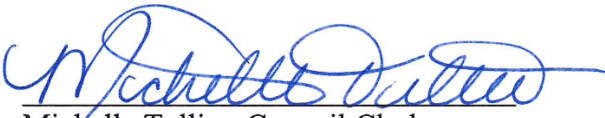
