The Chairman opened a public hearing for the purpose of receiving comment regarding the aforementioned item.

Mrs. Davis was recognized and advised that the Planning and Zoning Commission recommended denial of the aforementioned special use permit, on the grounds the commission believes the request fits in the R-2F zone.

Mr. Nicholas Lamotte was asked to speak briefly and answered a few questions for the Council, and also noted that he understands the wishes of Planning and Zoning.

Councilman Crowe explained in his opinion that Special Use permits are for requests that have special circumstances which make it hard or impossible to meet the applicable code, and this request does not have a special circumstance. Therefore, he agrees with Planning and Zoning that this should be a request for R-2F.

Chairman Denstel requested that the campers on the property be removed and the trash and debris also be cleaned up. He requested that the Planning and Development Office put in a complaint to get this parcel cleaned up. Regarding the permit request, Chairman Denstel agreed with Councilman Crowe that the zones need to be followed unless there is a special hardship.

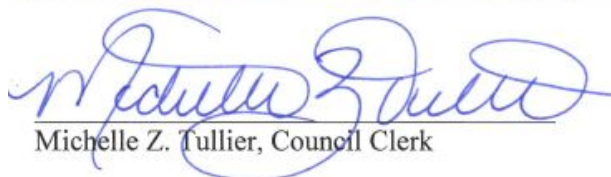

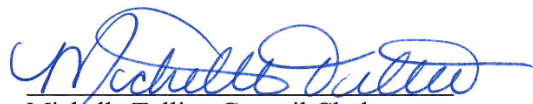

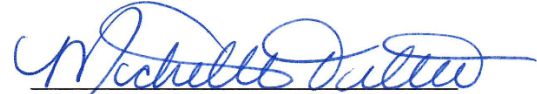

An Ordinance Amending The West Baton Rouge Parish Code of Ordinances, Louisiana, Amending Chapter 22 (Elections), Article II (Voting Districts), 22-26 (Designated), 22-27 (Voting District Descriptions), Article III (Voting Districts and Polling Places), Section 22-58 (Precinct Descriptions), and 22-59 (Polling Places)

WHEREAS, one of the primary functions of local governments is to protect the health, safety and welfare of its people; AND

WHEREAS, in exercising its role to carry-out the above, the West Baton Rouge Parish Council utilizes its police powers under the Constitution and laws of the State of Louisiana; AND

WHEREAS, such exercise of police power involves from time-to-time creating or amending local precincts and polling locations; AND

WHEREAS, the West Baton Rouge Parish Council has confirmed acceptance of this plan by the State Legislative Office and the Louisianan Secretary of State Office as by law; AND

WHEREAS, this ordinance is to format and codify the aforementioned ordinances into the WBR Parish Code of Ordinances.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the West Baton Rouge Parish Council, in regular session assembled, does hereby amend the following election information as previously adopted for codification purposes.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the West Baton Rouge Parish Council, in legal session, Chapter 22 (Elections), Article II (Voting Districts), 22-26 (Designated), 22-27 (Voting District Descriptions), Article III (Voting Districts and Polling Places), Section 22-58 (Precinct Descriptions), and 22-59 (Polling Places) of the Compiled Ordinances of the Parish of West Baton Rouge, Louisiana, is amended and re-enacted to read as follows:
