Councilman Gordon questioned if we had received an estimate on the connector road behind Choctaw connecting to Ed Lejeune, President Berthelot explained the road came in around nine million dollars, but added we have applied for some grants that hopefully would help with funding. Mr. Durbin was recognized and gave a brief rundown on the recent grant applications that have been applied for recently, regarding transportation projects.

Mr. Jim Ryan of Government Consultants Inc. was recognized and read aloud into the minutes the results from the last elections, stating there were 1,212 votes cast in favor and 582 votes cast against the Museum tax proposition, and there were 1,319 votes cast in favor and 478 votes cast against the Council on Aging tax proposition.

15. ALCOHOL PERMITS

A. Bucket's Bar & Grill located at 12812 Highway 190 W, Suite B Port Allen, La 70767, requesting Class A/R, Alcohol Restaurant Permit, change of ownership

Mr. Larry Bossier, and Mr. Gregory Duncan were recognized in regards to the aforementioned alcohol permit being requested. Councilman Crowe asked if this was for only the restaurant area or the whole facility. Mr. Duncan explained this was for the entire building, Councilman Crowe questioned if this was going to require one license or two and clarified if this was for an alcohol restaurant license only. Mr. Duncan explained the entire facility would be open and the area previously known as Raxx would have tables for seating in the restaurant. Questions were asked regarding

operating hours and Mr. Duncan confirmed 10am to 10pm, maybe 11pm, but stated it will not be run like a nightclub and will not be open until 2am, but will have some live entertainment. Mr. Duncan explained he wanted to take some walls down between the two previously addressed establishments. Councilman Crowe clarified originally the understanding of the application was to take over the alcohol restaurant license for KQ Grill as a restaurant. However, this applicant is asking for the Alcohol Restaurant license for the entire facility. Mrs. Tullier questioned section 6-155 of the Parish code which restricts the premises which have had a license revoked from having a permit issued for the time frame of one year. Mr. Lou Delahaye was recognized and gave his opinion that this is a different type of permit a restaurant and not a nightclub permit therefore this could be permitted. Councilman Crowe explained he was fine with this being an actual restaurant, but he is not fine with it being operated as a bar. Councilman Kershaw questioned part of the lease which included all property and a fight cage, and clarified with Mr. Duncan that there would not be any fights in the cage, and Mr. Duncan concurred there would not be any fights in said cage. Councilman Kershaw expressed that we would trust the applicant and attorneys word that this would be operated as a restaurant and not a bar.

A motion was made by Councilman Kirk Allain, seconded by Councilman Chris Kershaw to approve Bucket's Bar & Grill located at 12812 Highway 190 W, Port Allen, La 70767, requesting Class A/R, Alcohol Restaurant Permit, with the understanding this is a restaurant and not a bar.

Chairman Denstel questioned who would be the managers at this facility. Mr. Duncan replied he was the only manager and possibly his girlfriend. Mrs. Tullier explained that per our laws if anyone other than Mr. Duncan is acting as a manager they would need to come and complete further applications with the Sheriff and Parish, Mr. Duncan agreed.

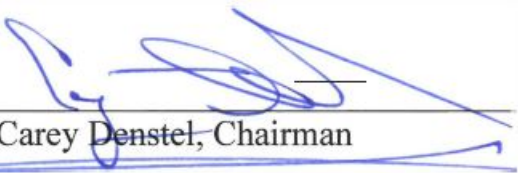

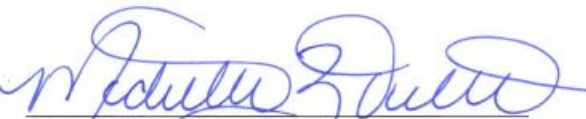

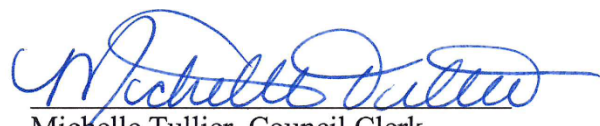

WHEREAS, the WEST BATON ROUGE PARISH GOVERNMENT is in need of funds to extend North Westport Road by 300 feet; and

WHEREAS, grants for this project may be available through Office of Community Development, Local Government Assistance Program (LGAP); and

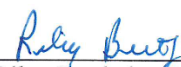

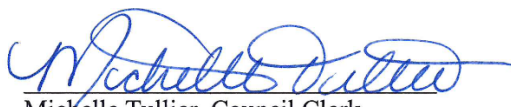

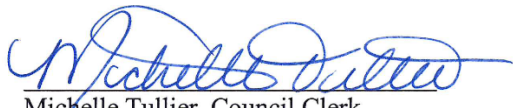
